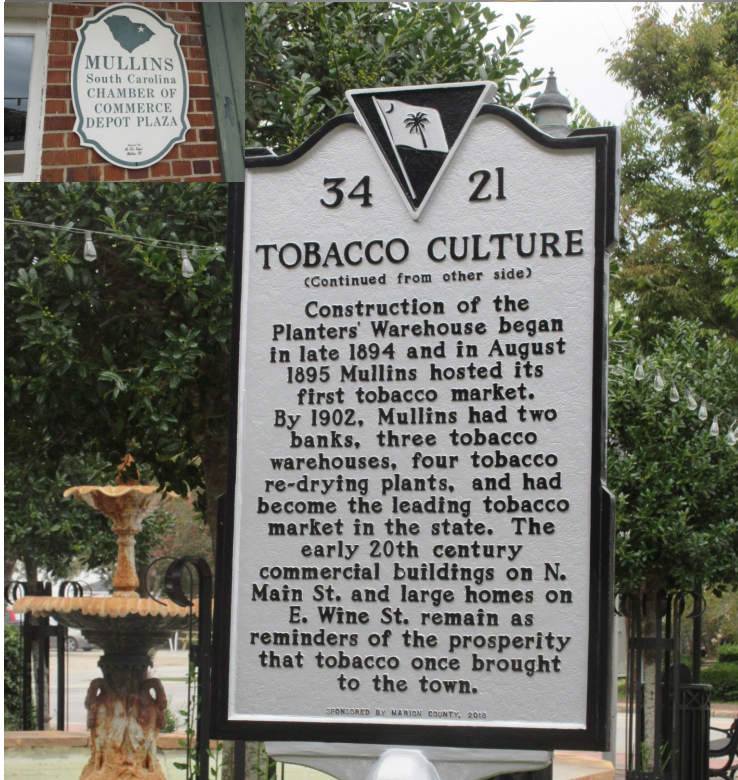


Mullins, South Carolina
